He especially enjoys the time he gets to spend with his Brother Knights while working to help the parish and the community.</p> <p>After being retired for three years, Ulysses realized that he really enjoys driving. He became a driver for Storer and hasn’t looked back. He loves being on the road. 	<p>TURLOCK PREGNANCY NEWS</p> <p>The Pregnancy Ctr. is in need of a second Ultrasound Machine. The machine that we bought (coming up on 6 years in August) is getting outdated and basically only has one or two years of service left without major repairs. Also, with patient demand, the Ctr. needs to double up on ultrasounds at times.</p>

An anonymous benefactor has come forth with a pledge to contribute ½ of the funds we would have raise. I have emailed the grand knights of the six councils that contributed in 2015, asking them to contribute. They were Fr. Heslin, OLA, All Saints, Patterson, Hughson, and Ceres. Also, we got contributions from YLI in Patterson, YMI in Hilmar, and All Saints Church. The benefactor’s willingness to contribute is limited in time and wants it done by Aug. 15. He will extend the time if he sees effort in our part.

Since we expect a large expense to go out in the next two months for the Food Truck Program (the improvements and redesign of the parking lot) I have approached the OLA Council to up front the money.... approx. \$10,000 to make it easier for us. I will know Their decision June 23. For the first machine in 2015, our council fronted the money and all other councils lived up to their pledges.

The following is the breakdown:

Machine cost	\$ 32,000.00
Sales tax	<u>2760.00</u>
Total cost	\$ 34,760.00
Supreme contribution ½ \$32K	- 16, 000.00
Combined council’s contribution	- 9,380.00
Benefactor’s matching funds	- 9,380.00

There possibly might be a second Benefactor that will contribute ½ of the councils \$9380.00 leaving \$4,690.00 for us to raise among all participating councils.

The request for this new machine has cleared the Stockton Diocese review. All we need now to do is prove to Supreme and the Benefactor that we have our share of the money in the bank.

Let us pray that we are successful in this project. The first machine has saved many, many lives. We will be able to save many more with this expansion.


